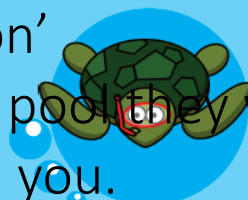


Welcome to the Pool at Hartwell Farm

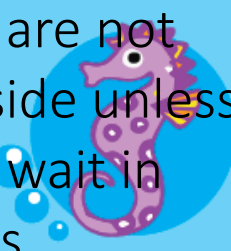


Things will look and feel a little different.

- Please wait in your car for a member of staff to greet you.
- Arrive no more than 5 mins before the start of your class.
- Please arrive with swimming costumes under outdoor clothes. This applies to babies, toddlers, children and adults.
- We will take your temperature when you arrive. If you have a raised temperature you will not be allowed to swim.
- You will have to sign a form to say you are well. A copy of this is enclosed with this email. You only need to submit this once. However if things change please send another form in by email.
- Sanitise your hands-on arrival and departure.
- Doors and windows to the pool house may be left open.
- Unfortunately, the showers will be closed. Please shower at home before and after swimming.
- Please always observe the 1m + social distancing rules.
- If you want to bring your own goggles, please ensure they are fitted by the accompanying adult prior to getting in the pool.
- If your child requires a tummy bands / woggles / arm bands, these must be secured and removed after the session by the accompanying adult.
- Our instructors will teach 'side on'
- When your child gets out of the pool they will need to follow the one-way system, as will you.



- Unfortunately from Monday 2nd November we are not allowed to accommodate any spectators pool side unless in extreme circumstances. You are welcome to wait in the marquee and observe through the windows.
- If you need to breast feed, we would prefer that you did this in your car to reduce numbers in the Pool House.
- Please bring your own baby changing mats and take all your used nappies home in a sealed bag. Please dispose of them at home.
- Changing rooms will be open for up to 6 people. There will be also be tents available for you to change once your swim has finished if you would prefer not to go home in your swimming things, however, we would prefer that you change at home.
- Toilets will be closed apart from in the case of an emergency.
- All lost property will be disposed off at the end of each day.
- Please do not wait around the carpark or the patio before or after your swim. This contravenes government guidelines around socialising.
- All equipment and doors / zips / handles / bins will be sanitised after each session. Please help us to avoid as much physical contact with hard surfaces as possible.
